Thank you for your letter of today's date which Wayne kindly forwarded me.

Thank you also for your continued support.

I wrote to you on 11th December formally applying for grant funding of £20,000 toward the upkeep of Waterside Pool and £10,000 toward the running costs of the Splash Park. With that letter I enclosed our Five Year Business Development Plan.
