ISLAND ROADS

Notice is hereby given that the Isle of Wight Council in not less than seven days from the appearance of this Notice, under Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, proposes to make the following Orders: -

The Isle of Wight Council (Public Footpath N32, Newport, Isle of Wight) (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrians and Cyclists) Order No 1 2019

Island Roads on behalf of The Isle of Wight Council give notice that from approx. 0730 hours on Monday 29 July 2019 until 1600 hours on Monday 9 September 2019, or when the works have been completed, no person shall cause any pedestrian or cyclist, to proceed along Public Footpath N32, Newport, between its junctions with Riverway and Dodnor Lane subway. The alternative route will be signposted locally. The closure is required for safety during footway surfacing.

The Isle of Wight Council (Osborne Road, Shanklin, Isle of Wight) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order No 3 2019

The Isle of Wight Council (Wilkes Road, Sandown, Isle of Wight) (Temporary One-Way Restriction and Revocation) Order No 1 2019
