Proposal By Way of Notice of Motion

Following the rescission of the decision taken by Full Council in respect of CCTV on 2 July 2018 the Council now tasks the Planning Committee to consider this matter again using the following terms of reference:

1. To liaise with IWC, Island Roads and the police to identify the need for CCTV and how it could be funded and provided

2. To apply due diligence to further explore the purchase of CCTV (deployable or fixed) in compliance with the

- Information Commissioners Office
- The Regulation of Investigatory Powers Act 2000
- The Protection of Freedoms Act 2012
- Data Protection Legislation, including the General Data Protection Regulations 2018
- Freedom of Information Act 2000
- Human Rights Act 1998
- Surveillance Camera Code of Practice

3. To consider the Town Councils Contract Standing Orders in relation to procurement in any proposed way forward.

4. To consider any updated budgetary implications of any proposals going forward as a result of the above.

5. Enable the Clerks to seek specialist and legal advice if required.
