Proposal:

To express the Town Council's opposition to the proposed withdrawal of the Isle of Wight Council's Local Area Coordination Service, on the grounds that it will have a negative impact on the Island's most vulnerable residents and increase the pressure on health and welfare services.

Proposal By Way of Notice of Motion

The Town Council will inform the Isle of Wight Council that we:

1. Note the valuable work being done by the Ryde Local Area Coordinator;
2. Oppose the proposed withdrawal of the Local Area Coordination service;
3. Consider that the proposed withdrawal would have a negative impact on the wellbeing of the Island's most vulnerable residents and increase the pressure on our already overstretched health and welfare services.

Budget Implications

None at present. However, we understand that the Isle of Wight Council may approach parish and town councils to take over the service.
